You should have adequate time to complete the examination; however, you can not afford to spend an excessive amount of time on any question.

The test covers a broad range of accounting topics and you may use a college level text and/or the class module to help you prepare for the exam.

Unless a candidate has completed the equivalent of AC410a Intermediate Accounting I fairly recently in a reputable accounting program or has successfully completed the AC410a challenge exam **and** has had significant exposure through their employment to the higher level accounting topics covered in this course, the probability of successfully completing the examination is **not** good!
