



The Daniels Opportunity Scholarship

Regis University College for Professional Studies (CPS) has received a \$125,000 Daniels Fund grant to support adult learners from Colorado who want to complete their undergraduate degrees at Regis University.

Regis University CPS has been a leader in adult accelerated education for 30 years, and it is keenly aware of the unique needs of adults as well as the factors that lead to student success. The Daniels Opportunity Scholarship will enable 15 adult undergraduates who represent four nontraditional populations to complete baccalaureate degrees. The maximum scholarship is \$5000 per year for each of two years of study. Scholarship monies must be used by December 31, 2010.

Eligibility

Selection is competitive. Applicants will be selected from graduates of Colorado community colleges who have earned Associate of Arts, Associate of Science or Associate of Applied Science degrees. Applicants who are community college graduates and active military, retired military, veterans or National Guard, spouses of military, GED recipients, and students pursuing EMT/ Paramedic training will receive priority in selection. Adult, community college graduates from traditionally unrepresented groups are encouraged to apply.

Students must be residents of Colorado or stationed in Colorado. Scholarship funding provides support for tuition, fees, books, supplies, insurance and commuting costs related to enrollment in the College for Professional Studies at Regis University.

How to Apply

Application deadline is March 30. Funding is available for those candidates selected as Scholars beginning in Summer Semester, 2009. To be considered, applicants must apply to Regis University College for Professional Studies, must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) www.fafsa.ed.gov and the Daniels Scholarship Application available online at www.transfertoregis.org
