***SELF-HELP & GENERAL TIPS:**

This comprehensive resource guide contains hundreds of profiles on local foundations and trusts, corporations, national funders, government agencies, and religious organizations. Search by funder type or keywords, or use the advanced search options for more detailed searching.

Colorado Nonprofit Association

An advocacy coalition of Colorado nonprofits of all sizes. The site offers everything from job postings to pertinent legislative updates, to a calendar of nonprofit events, help with grant writing, advice on starting a nonprofit, and networking contact information. This site now includes information formerly contained in the Directory of Colorado Nonprofits (accessed from "Member Search" or "Business Member Search").

Foundation Directory

Directory of over 65,000 foundations and more than 150,000 grants. Search by areas of interest, types of support, location, foundation name, etc. Passwords are available at the reference desk.

Philanthropic Studies Index

Index to literature (popular and scholarly journals) on voluntarism, nonprofit organizations, fundraising, and charitable giving, covering from 1940 to the present.

Chronicle of Philanthropy

(requires special password & login—call the Reference Desk @ 1-800-388-2366 x4031) From the Regis Library homepage, click on Lumen, select “journal title” and type in Chronicle of Philanthropy. The record displayed will contain an electronic link to the journal. (*some years also available in Academic Search Premier*)
