

Accounting Research Guide (library web page, click on [Research by Subject](#))

For suggested databases and other materials useful for accounting research, including citation guides and information on obtaining materials.

- **Accounting and Auditing Literature.** An American Institute of Certified Public Accountants (AICPA) resource that includes AICPA Professional Standards, Accounting Trends and Techniques, AICPA Technical Practice Aids, and the Audit and Accounting Guides Set. Contains AICPA Position Statements, Practice Bulletins, Audit Risk Alerts, and the reporting methods of 600 top industrial, merchandising, technology and service corporations. *Note: individual registration is required to use these resources!*
 1. Go to www.cpa2biz.com (not the link on the Regis Library web page)
 2. Click on “sign in.”
 3. Click on “New User. Register Now.”
 4. Click on “Non-AICPA New Users Register Here, Continue.”
 5. Complete all information and save. Do not sign out.
 6. Open up the Regis Library web site in a separate window.
 7. Select “Accounting and Auditing Literature” from the A-Z database list under Quick Links.
 8. Click on “Sign in” and enter newly created username and password.
 9. Click on “Access Online Subscriptions.”
 10. Click on AICPA Core Library.
- **Business Source Premier.** Full-text articles from over 7,400 journals and other sources in management, economics, finance, accounting, and international business, including the Harvard Business Review. Includes peer-reviewed (1,000+) and general business magazines (1,200+), country economic reports, industry yearbooks and market research reports.
- **CCH Internet Tax Research Network.** A library of federal and state tax codes, tax court decisions, revenue rulings, and CCH editorial explanations. Locate the **GAAP Guides** by selecting Browse for Accounting and Audit → GAAP library. You can then either use the Browse menu to drill down to specific sections of the guides, or use the check boxes to select content you want to search.
- **Lumen**
 - A search box for Lumen, the Regis Libraries’ catalog, can be found on the library homepage in the lower left corner.
 - Lumen includes records for all print and electronic books the library has in its collection. Look for links in the catalog record that allow you to access any of the e-books listed in your search results.
- **Books 24x7**
 - Using the Browse menu on the My Home page, view relevant books by selecting the “Finance Topics” collection.
 - Search the full content of the database on an accounting term and find books and book chapters ranked by relevance.
