

Remote Access to Library Databases

RegisNET Account. This account is required for off-campus access to library databases and for requesting materials. To apply, go to <http://webadvisor.regis.edu> , look for the *RegisNET Account* link and fill out the form.

Research by Subject

Located under **Research** on the library home page, this link provides access to research resources, including databases and recommended web sites, organized by broad subject areas.

Article Linker (“Check for full text”)

- Article Linker indicates whether or not you have access to a particular article or journal in one of the Regis online databases, or if Regis subscribes to the journal in a non-electronic format.
- Article Linker is launched when you click on the Check for full text links in Academic Search Premier and other databases. Articles that are not available full text can be ordered by clicking on the Interlibrary Loan Login link.

Lumen

- Located on the libraries’ web page under **Research - Find Books, DVDs and more**
- Includes the holdings of Regis University’s Libraries

Prospector

- Located on the libraries’ web page under **Research - Find Books, DVDs and more**
- Prospector includes the holdings of Colorado libraries, including Regis.
- You can request books directly from Regis and other libraries, but must pick them up at a Regis Colorado campus site. Use your Regis ID number for Prospector requests.

Interlibrary Loan – (formerly “Loan Ranger”) located under **Services - Request articles and books** on the libraries’ web page.

- Log in using your RegisNET username and password
- The first time you log in, you’ll be prompted to fill in personal profile information.
- Can be used for distance students to request materials from Regis or Prospector libraries, or for anyone to request materials through Interlibrary Loan.
- You can also use Interlibrary Loan to request specific articles when you’re searching library databases. Follow the Check for full text links first to see if the article you need is available in another database. If it is not, use the Interlibrary Loan Login link.

Citing Periodical Articles From Full-Text Databases - Consult with your course instructor to make sure you are using the correct format.

- **Accessing Full-Text Resources Online** helps demystify using Article Linker to find full-text articles.
- **Interlibrary Loan** gives you the lowdown on making interlibrary loan requests.
