

Wilderness First Responder Certification

Join OAP this Winter Break for the Wilderness First Responder (WFR) Certification class taught by the pros at Wilderness Medicine Institute (WMI). WMI is a division of the National Outdoor Leadership School (NOLS). The WFR certification is a nationally recognized program that trains participants how to respond to emergency situations in a remote setting. This training is highly recommended for anyone that enjoys the outdoors, whether it's backpacking, rock climbing, skiing, hiking, or any other activity that is always in your thoughts. The 80-hour curriculum lasts 11 days and will be held on campus from Friday, January 8 to Sunday, January 17. The course will primarily be taught on campus expect for one excursion day. The cost is \$600 and the Certification from the Wilderness Medicine Institute will last 2 years. For students that need some more credits the University of Utah will provide students with 3 college credits for an additional fee of \$200.



WFR Certification Cost: \$600

- A deposit of \$300 is required to reserve your spot.
- Payment must be paid in full by the first day of class

Cost Includes:

- 11 days of outdoor emergency training from Wilderness Medicine Institute staff.
- 2 year certification from Wilderness Medicine Institute.
- Additional confidence in the backcountry. Priceless!

Extra Costs:

- 3 College Credit from the University of Utah: \$200.
- On-campus housing for Regis University on-campus Students Only:
 - **West Hall Single:** \$307 for 10 days
 - **West Hall Double:** \$228 for 10 days
 - **Residence Village & Ignatian Single:** \$342 for 10 days
 - **Residence Village & Ignatian Double:** \$264 for 10 days
