

2009-2010 FAFSA Income Appeal

Please note: 2009-10 Income Appeals will be accepted only until March 31, 2010.

The FAFSA Income Appeal should be submitted only if you feel your current financial situation is not accurately reflected on the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) form. Your appeal will not be reviewed until your financial aid application is complete. Before submitting the FAFSA Income Appeal, be sure to:

- Submit the 2009-2010 FAFSA to the Department of Education.
- Submit a Regis University 2009-2010 Institutional Verification Form.
- Submit signed copies of your (and your spouse's) 2008 Federal Income Tax returns.
- Submit signed copies of your parent's 2008 Federal Income Tax returns, if applicable.

The accuracy of the information provided on the FAFSA must be verified before any adjustments are considered. As a result of the FAFSA Income Appeal, awards may be adjusted, in some cases resulting in a reduced amount of financial aid.
