Federal legislation has mandated a nationwide transition to electronic medical records, making Health Information Management (HIM) among the fastest growing careers available. Prepare yourself to take on a wide variety of technical, managerial and consultative roles and become an invaluable member of any health care team. *The HIM program is accredited by the Commission on Accreditation for Health Informatics and Information Management Education (CAHIIM).* Students in the HIM program have the option to progress into the M.S. in Health Care Informatics & Information Management program for 30 credits instead of the full 36 credit hours.
