

The Missing Piece in Leadership

A huge part of success as a leader is gauged by how well one orchestrates a set of people to produce the desired outcome. This session will dissolve the mystery of why that has appeared to be so hard to accomplish.

The Missing Piece in Leadership: How to Create the Future You Want, the book upon which this half-day is based, is written for leaders who are doing their best at what they've been taught and still not getting the desired results.

Directions to Regis University Claver Hall (formerly the Adult Learning Center)

Westbound: Take I-70 to the Federal Blvd exit. • Proceed north on Federal Blvd to first stop light (Regis Blvd on the left and W. 50th Ave on the right). • Turn left onto Regis Blvd and go to first stop light (Lowell Blvd). • Turn right onto Lowell Blvd and proceed north past Lot 3 to Lot 4 (about half way down hill on your right).

Eastbound: Take I-70 to the Federal Blvd exit. • Proceed north (left) on Federal Blvd to Regis Blvd (50th). • Take a left on Regis Blvd • Take a right on Lowell Blvd and go north to Lot 4.
