



Personal Conduct Agreement

Participants in Club Sports are accountable to the Student Code of Conduct, the Coaches and the Office of Student Activities for their conduct for the duration of the season. This includes all practices, games, and travel to and from competition.

Participants are required to observe all applicable laws and ordinances of applicable governmental authorities as well as the rules and regulations of service providers, including hotels, hostels and airlines.

Violations of conduct codes, laws, or provisions may result in penalties including, but not limited to, termination of your participation in the season or competition. Further, any participant who violates these standards will remain liable for any and all expenses related to the event and related travel, as well as the amount of costs incurred by Regis resulting from, in any way, the misconduct of the participant.

Regis University is not responsible for providing legal assistance to students who violate laws or service providers' regulations.

If Applicable,

Participants who are of legal age for the consumption of alcoholic beverages in the host country may do so; however, at no time, may alcohol be consumed in excess. Students who become intoxicated, who violate alcohol or other controlled substance laws or regulations of the host country or any of its political subdivisions, or of host institutions or facilities, or who use controlled substances of any kind will be subject to discipline through the University conduct system.

Participants on a trip agree not to leave activities or accommodations independently of the group and to keep the coach informed of their whereabouts at all times. Participants further agree to set, in consultation with the Coach and/or Coaches, reasonable times for their return to hotel accommodations each night and to abide by those time limitations.

Participants agree that they will abide by decisions of the Coaches in the event of emergency situations. Participants will provide the University with medical insurance information and emergency contacts prior to departure.

Participants agree to have medical insurance in effect that covers medical emergencies while traveling and in all locations, including foreign countries. Further, participants must provide evidence of this medical insurance to trip leaders prior to departure.
