# Religious Travel International, LLC – Terms and Conditions

**By making a deposit or paying in full for your Religious Travel International LLC, (RTI), trip, you acknowledge and agree to the terms and conditions set forth below.**

## DEPOSIT & RESERVATION

A \$500 per person deposit is required at the time of booking with a completed application. The initial deposit must be received within 5 days of receiving your application. Additional deposits will be required for certain packages and will be indicated on the initial quote. Payment of the deposit constitutes acceptance of the itinerary.

## PAYMENT

Bank or Certified Checks or Money Orders are accepted forms of payment at any time. Personal checks are acceptable if received more than 30 days prior to departure date. Returned checks will incur a \$75 service fee. In case of computer or human billing error, we reserve the right to re-invoice participants with corrected billing.

## PRICE GUARANTEE

Rates are based on double or twin occupancy. All prices are shown in U.S. Dollars and are calculated on currency rates and fares in existence on date of final payment. Religious Travel International, LLC, (RTI), reserves the right to alter prices at any time prior to departure and without prior notice if circumstances so warrant. Any devaluation or revaluation of currencies may affect published price.

## NOT INCLUDED

Passport & Visa fees, as well as Customs & Immigration Fees are not included. Also not included are items of a personal nature, such as telephone calls, mini bar, laundry, etc. (These extra items will be billed to you before leaving the hotel or restaurant).

## PASSPORTS, VISAS & DOCUMENTS

A valid US passport is required for US citizens. Passports must be valid at least 6 months after return date. For non-US citizens, please consult the country's consulate. When and if a Visa is required, it is the passenger's responsibility to obtain one. Cancellations due to lack of appropriate documents will incur the usual penalties. Passport information, including passport number, expiration date and date of birth, is required to confirm services.

## FINAL DOCUMENTS

Final documents are issued upon receipt of final payment only and within 3 weeks of departure. Documents are not guaranteed if final payment is not received on time. Upon receipt of your documents you are responsible to check your itinerary, spelling of your name, dates, times and other important information to insure their validity. Should your final documents have any errors, it is the passenger's responsibility to contact RTI immediately.

## CANCELLATIONS AND REFUNDS

Once a deposit or partial/full payment has been made, cancellations will only be accepted in writing. Cancellation terms will be applied based on the date that the written cancellation is received. A \$350 nonrefundable charge is applied to all cancellations.

Refundable amounts of price prior to departure –

90 days prior to departure ..... 15%

89 - 45 days prior to departure.....30%

44 days prior to departure.....no refund

(Also, additional cancellation penalties may apply to air travel as all air is contracted 100% non-refundable.)

## TRAVEL PROTECTION

## AIR TRANSPORTATION

All air carriers are independent contractor and are not

owned, managed, controlled or operated by RTI and have their own cancellation policies, which are applied and followed with no exception. All air is based on economy class seating, 100% non-refundable and non-endorsable at time of purchase. Your airline ticket constitutes a contract between yourself and the airline (and not RTI), even if purchased through RTI. Prior to payment, airlines may impose fuel surcharges or tax increases with or without notification, which are the responsibility of the passenger. Once payment is made, RTI considers any fees associated to changes or cancellation is the responsibility of the passenger.

## SEAT ASSIGNMENT

Random seats are assigned for all group participants. If you must have specific seat, we recommend you to be at the airport at least three hours prior to departure and arrange the seat assignment with your airline's gate agent. Bulkhead and exit row seating can never be requested prior to the day of departure. RTI can never guarantee specific seats, which are at the discretion of the airline & are pending availability, subject to aircraft/seat map changes.

## HOTEL ACCOMMODATIONS

Hotel accommodations are based on twin-bedded or double rooms. RTI reserves the right to substitute similar category hotels without prior notice.

## PRIVATE ROOMS and SINGLE SUPPLEMENT

A limited number of single rooms are available (on request basis only) at the supplement price.

## TRIPLE ROOMS

Triple rooms are not available on this pilgrimage.

## MEALS

Special meals cannot be guaranteed, but RTI will try to accommodate your needs: however you must indicate at initial booking any special meal requirements. In case you choose not to have a meal, there is no refund for unused meals.

## BAGGAGE RULES

Baggage rules are set by each individual airline and subject to change at any time. Generally each tour participant is permitted to bring one checked suitcase, one small carry-on bag (8" x 14" x 22"), and one personal item (i.e. purse, laptop case). In general, the airlines permit 1 checked bag weighing up to 50 lbs. (23 kg) and maximum dimensions of 62 in. (158 cm) (calculated by adding the length + the width + the height of the bag). Please check with your specific airline to verify the size and weight allowances. RTI is not responsible for the loss of, theft of, delay, or damage to a participant's belongings.

## RESPONSIBILITY

RTI acts as a tour operator. The suppliers providing transportation, meals, sightseeing arrangements and hotel accommodations for the tour program are independent contractors and are not agents or employees of RTI. By utilizing the service of the suppliers, you agree that RTI will not be liable for any change in flight or itinerary schedule due to circumstances beyond its control, such as strikes, acts of governments, acts of war and/or terrorism, war, or acts of God or nature. Though every effort will be made to follow the itinerary, it should be considered as an indication of the tour, rather than a contract of places to be visited. Occasionally, local religious holidays, national holidays, traffic conditions and other events may necessitate changes in the sequence of visits or the missing of certain visits. RTI is not responsible for compensation for cities/sites omitted from the itinerary due to circumstances beyond its control.

## SPECIAL MEDICAL CONDITIONS

You must report any disability requiring special attention to RTI at the time of registration. We make every effort to accommodate disabled passengers; however, we cannot guarantee and are not responsible for any denial of

services by carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

Where the Americans with Disabilities Act is not applicable, facilities for disabled individuals may be limited. We regret that we cannot provide individual assistance to any tour participant for walking, dining, while in their room, on flight, or getting on and off motor coaches and other vehicles. Additionally, airlines are not able to guarantee or provide assistance for disabled tour participants, including special seating. A qualified and physically able companion must accompany travelers who need special assistance. Pregnant women considering international travel should be advised to evaluate the potential problems as well as the quality of medical care available at the destination and during transit. RTI is not responsible for any medical condition that occurs prior to, during or after the tour.

## YOUNG TRAVELERS

Travelers who are less than 18 years old on the departure date must be accompanied by an adult. Due to heightened security, many countries have adopted practices to prevent international abductions of children. If a child will be traveling with adults other than the parents or with only one parent, it is recommended that a notarized letter be written, by the parents or non-traveling parent, granting authorization for the child to travel internationally, including the travel dates. We also suggest that you contact the appropriate consulate and airlines because they may have additional requirements.

## SAFETY

Please be aware that during your participation on tours operated by RTI, certain risks and dangers may arise beyond our control. RTI does not have liability regarding provisions of medical care or the adequacy of any care that may be rendered.

## PHYSICALITY OF OUR TOURS

Please note that almost all destinations serviced by RTI require physical fitness and a lot of walking, sometimes up or down hills; and at times, on rough terrain. You may certainly stay behind for some parts of the journey; however, it is suggested that 3 to 4 weeks before your departure, you should begin preparing physically by walking one or two times a day. Build up to 4-6 miles with no discomfort.

## SERVICE INQUIRIES AFTER THE TRIP
