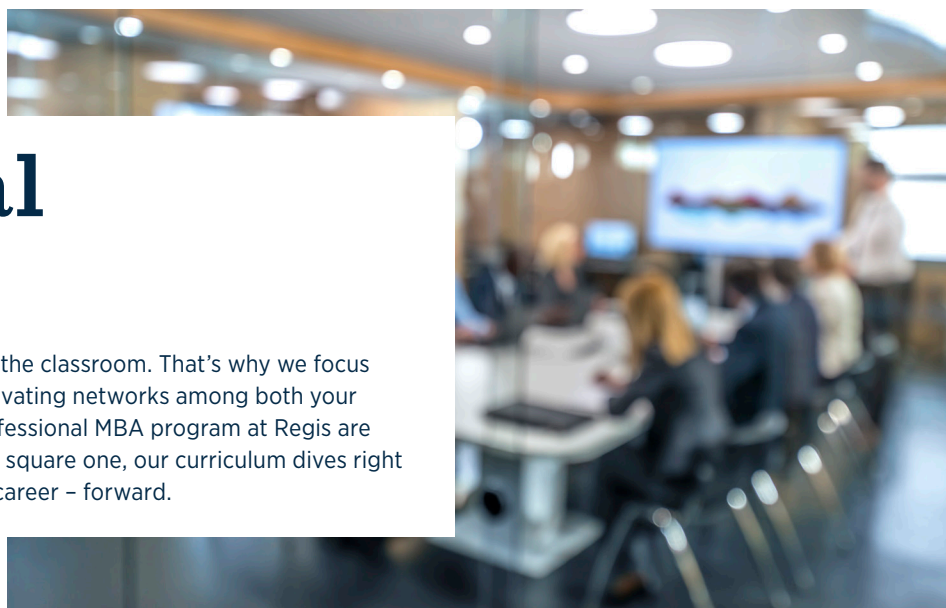


# Professional MBA
