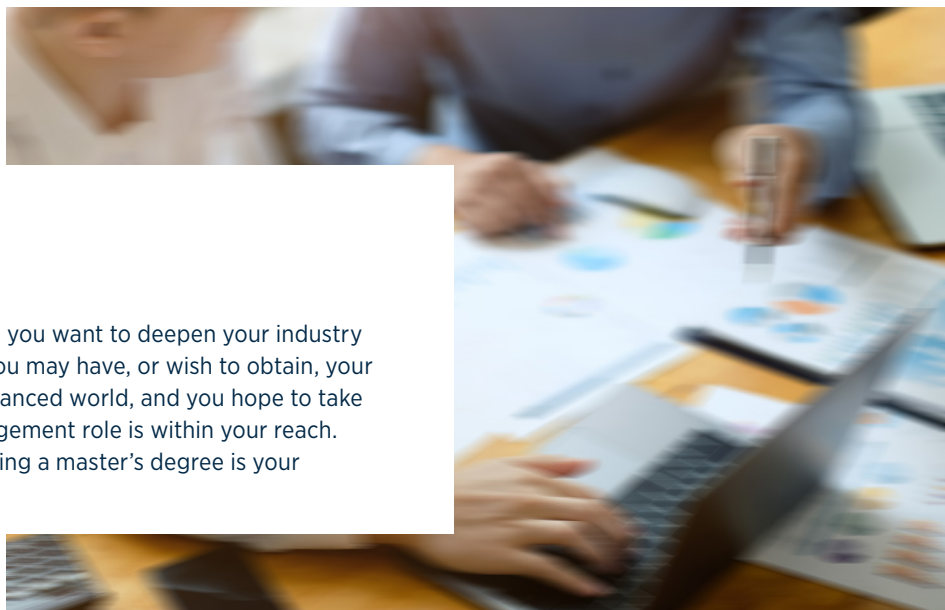


Accounting
