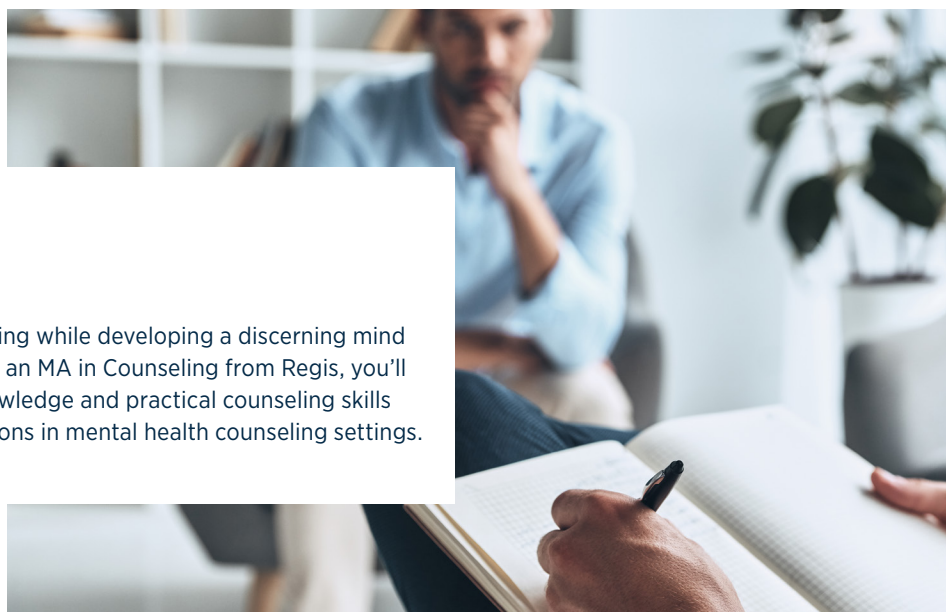


Counseling
