To apply to the Dermatology Nurse Practitioner Fellowship program, vou will need:

- I One year experience working as a nurse practitioner required
- I MS in Nursing: Nurse Practitioner
- I Degree bearing BSN and MSN official transcripts
- Resume
- I Two letters of recommendation
- I Copy of nursing certification
- Essay
