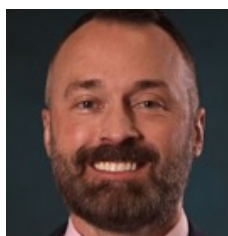

To apply to the Family Nurse Practitioner (FNP) post-graduate certificate program, you will need:

- | Complete NursingCAS online application
- | Nursing Master's degree from an NLN or AACN-CCNE accredited program
- | Minimum two years nursing work experience
- | Official degree-bearing transcripts
- | Current resume
- | One-page personal statement
- | Three NursingCAS recommendation forms

The first step in the application process is to contact an admissions counselor, who can evaluate your prior learning credit, provide information regarding financial aid and tuition assistance and help you through the entire application process.
