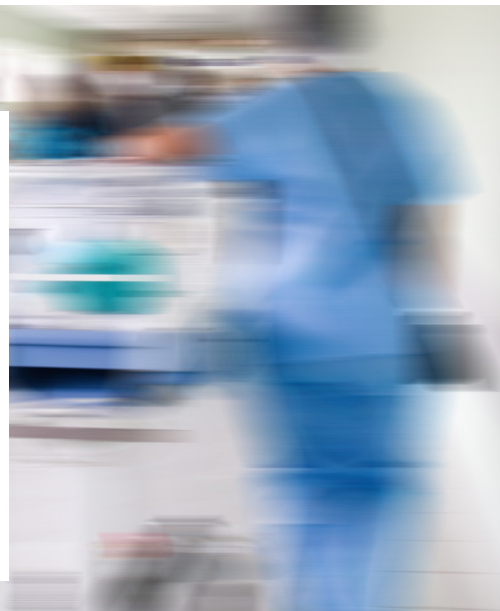


Neonatal Nurse Practitioner (NNP)

The Neonatal Nurse Practitioner Post-Master's Certificate is an ideal solution if you already have an M.S. in Nursing degree or its equivalent and want to become a neonatal nurse practitioner. The curriculum focuses on assessment, management and evaluation of the health care needs of neonates and infants working within the dynamics of the family environment and in collaboration with neonatologists and other health care providers.

- | Minimum two years nursing work experience in a Level III or IV high-risk neonatal intensive care unit
- | Completed NursingCAS online application
- | Completion of an NLN or AACN-CCNE accredited graduate-level nursing program with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0
- | All official transcripts
- | Current resume
- | One-page personal statement
- | Three recommendation forms (one each from a supervisor, NNP or Neonatologist)

- | Priority deadline: March 1
- | Final deadline: July 1
- | Program starts: Late August
