## What you'll need

### TO APPLY:

- Completed online application
- Doctor of Pharmacy (Pharm.D.) degree\*
- Official Pharm.D. degree-bearing transcripts to be evaluated for requisite number of hours of courses including pharmacoconomics, research design and biostatistics

The first step in the application process is to contact an admissions counselor, who can evaluate your prior learning credit, provide information regarding financial aid and tuition assistance and help you through the entire application process.

*\*Students currently enrolled in at least their second year of study (P2) in a Pharm.D. program with good academic standing are also eligible for this certificate program.*

*Current Regis Pharm.D. students who are interested in pursuing this certificate should contact their academic advisor about their eligibility and enrollment options.*
