To apply directly to the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program, you will need: Completed online application

- Nursing graduate degree from an NLN or AACN-CCNE accredited program from a regionally-accredited institution
- I Official transcripts from all post-secondary institutions attended
- I Resume including professional and volunteer experience
- Active RN license
- I Admissions interview may be required

#### ELIGIBILITY:

- I Minimum GPA of 3.0 or higher, with a grade of "B" or better in all graduate nursing courses
- I Eligibility pending successful completion of drug screening and criminal background check
- I Health assessment and physical examination indicating appropriate immunizations and physical ability to meet the objectives of the DNP program
