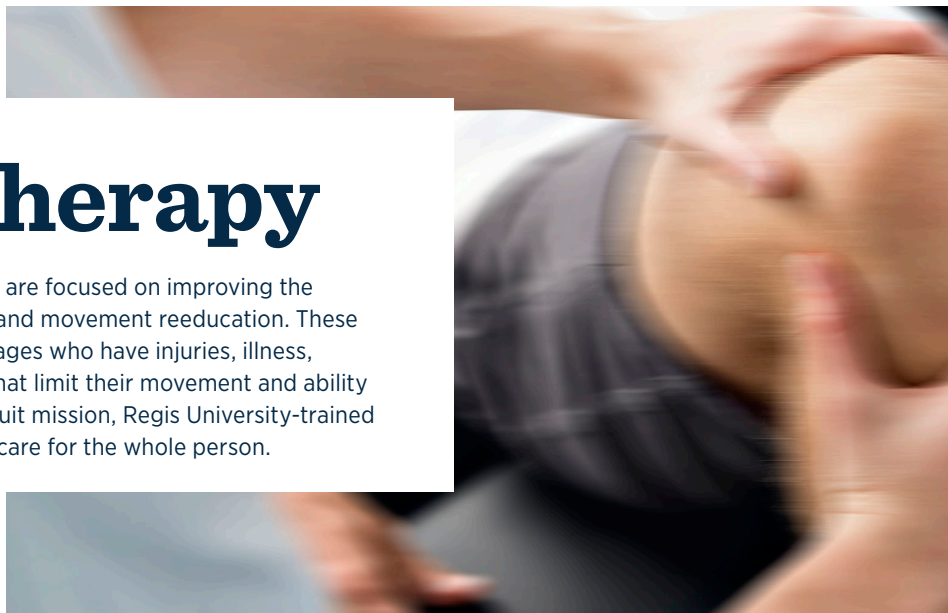


Physical Therapy

What you'll need:

TO APPLY

Applicants must submit all required admission materials as instructed on the Physical Therapist Centralized Application Service (PTCAS) application, including:

- | Completed PTCAS application
- | Official university and/or college transcripts sent directly to PTCAS
- | 3 electronic letters of recommendation (one must be completed by a licensed physical therapist and one by college-level faculty)
- | GRE optional

The most qualified applicants who demonstrate alignment with the University mission “to create a more just and humane world”, will receive a written invitation for a faculty interview conducted in January.

ELIGIBILITY

The following must be completed prior to matriculation to maintain eligibility for the DPT program:

- Completion of baccalaureate degree in a field other than Physical Therapy
- Satisfactory completion of prerequisite course work with a minimum 2.75 prerequisite GPA
- Successful completion of drug screening and criminal background check

CLINICAL EXPERIENCE

DPT students complete a total of 38 weeks of clinical experience, which is integrated throughout the curriculum. The School of Physical Therapy is affiliated with clinical facilities throughout the United States, and some abroad.
