HOW TO APPLY

To be eligible for the alternative teacher licensure program, you must:

- Hold a .5 FTE or greater position in a school in the content area of which you're seeking licensure (may be public, private, charter or independent school)
- 1) 24 credit hours in the selected content area OR 2) Pass the content area PRAXIS exam OR 3) Possess a major in the chosen content area

To apply to the alternative teacher licensure program, you will need:

- I Completed online application
- Resume
- Bachelor's degree
- Official transcripts from all previous colleges/universities attended, including official degree-bearing transcript from a regionally accredited institution
