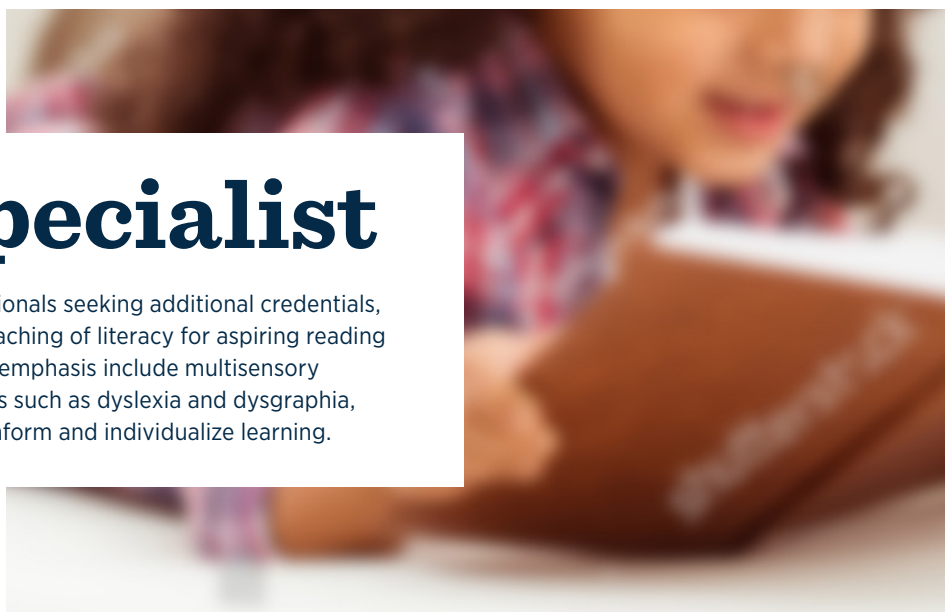


Reading Specialist

Designed for licensed teachers and for professionals seeking additional credentials, the M.Ed. in Reading program enhances the teaching of literacy for aspiring reading interventionists and literacy coaches. Areas of emphasis include multisensory instruction, literacy-specific learning disabilities such as dyslexia and dysgraphia, instructional interventions, and using data to inform and individualize learning.

Two available program options:

M.ED. READING WITH READING SPECIALIST ENDORSEMENT

For licensed teachers in Colorado who are interested in addressing the needs of students with dyslexia, dysgraphia and other learning challenges. This program culminates in a university-supervised practicum focusing on students who have documented or suspected reading disabilities.

M.ED. READING (DEGREE ONLY)

For licensed teachers interested in increasing literacy knowledge and expertise, and for those seeking literacy-focused teaching positions. This program culminates in an online capstone course, which is taken online during the summer.
