#### FIELD WORK AND STUDENT TEACHING

Students should expect to complete 200 field hours while completing their course work. Student teaching requires full-time enrollment in the program and must be completed at an accredited institution within the state of Colorado. Regis has over 100 partner schools and will work to pair you with the right grade level in a supportive atmosphere. Students must pass the state-required licensing exam (PRAXIS) before applying to student teaching.

#### **INITIAL LICENSURE**

After completing your field hours in a Colorado school, you can apply for licensure in Colorado through the Colorado Department of Education with our recommendation. A total of 800 hours of fieldwork and student teaching are required for licensure, as well as successful completion of the PRAXIS licensing exam.
