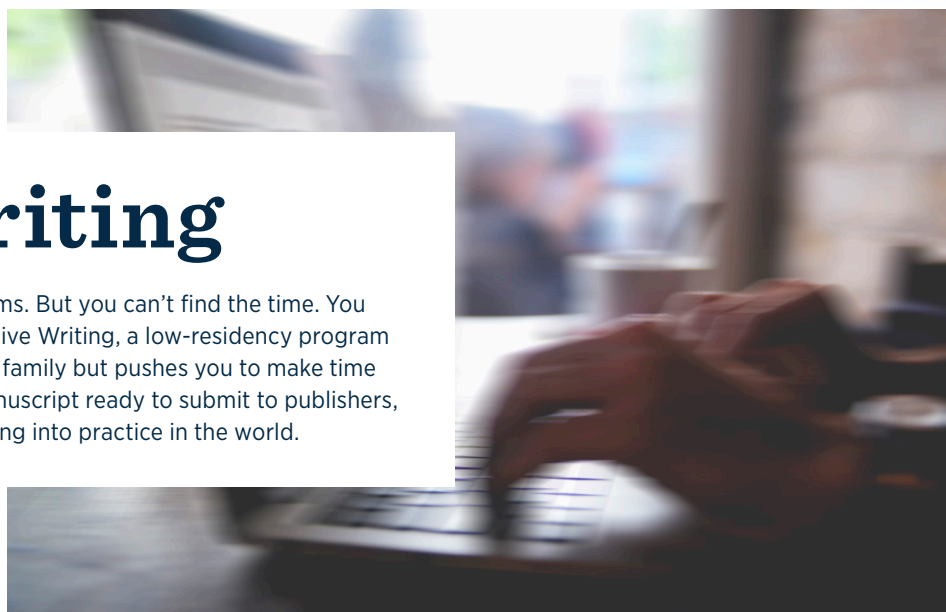


Creative Writing

RESIDENCY INFORMATION

Twice a year, in January and July, students attend nine-day residencies at our Northwest Denver campus. Residencies are held from Friday evening to the following Sunday afternoon. Each residency includes:

- Writing workshops
- Seminars on theory, craft, the study of canonical works and the business of publishing
- Mentor/student meetings and interviews
- Evening readings and discussions
- Visiting writer chats and readings

The fifth residency also features:

- Readings of students' critical essays
- Thesis defense
- Action plans to help students use their writing to contribute to the common good
- Graduation ceremony
