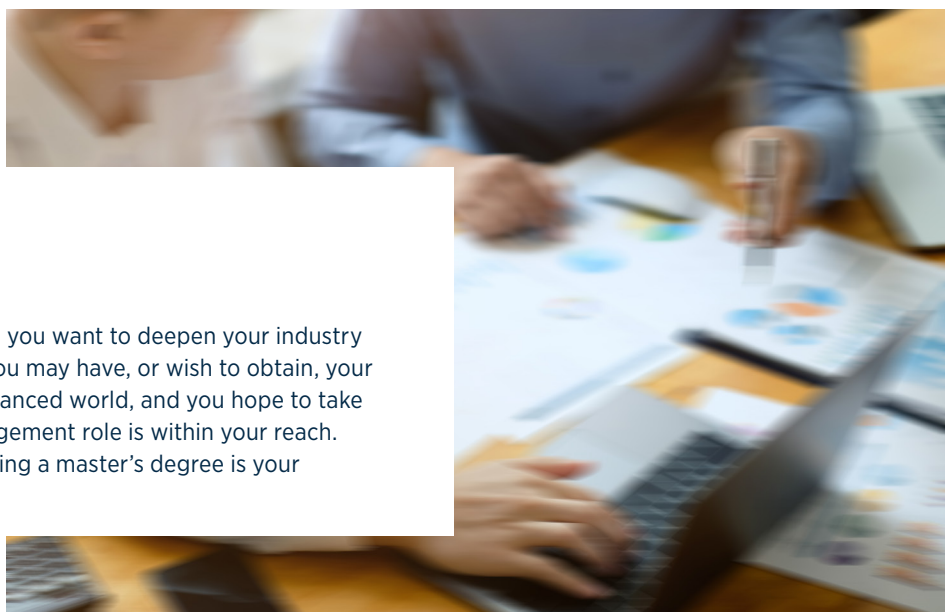


# Accounting
