| WHAT CLASS FORMATS CAN I CHOOSE FROM?

Pharm.D. classes are held on campus. MBA classes are typically held online.

| HOW QUICKLY CAN I COMPLETE THE PROGRAM?

The Pharm.D. program typically takes four years to complete. Six additional MBA courses can be taken online in the summers, allowing students to earn both degrees concurrently.

| WHEN CAN I START?

MBA start dates are available every 8 weeks once a student has been admitted to the Pharm.D. program.

Program Components

PHARM.D. REQUIREMENTS

150 program credits are required for the Doctor of Pharmacy Degree. The Pharm.D. portion of the program is typically completed in four years.

MBA/PHARM.D. CLASSES

Earn an MBA by completing 12 qualifying graduate courses, six of which can be taken as requirements or electives during the Pharm.D. portion of the program.

MBA REQUIREMENTS

The additional six MBA courses can be taken online in 8-week terms over the summer, making it easy to earn your MBA and Pharm.D. concurrently.

TO APPLY:

Students interested in earning both the Doctor of Pharmacy and the Master of Business Administration degrees must apply for, be accepted into and enroll in both programs. and enroll in both programs.

The Pharmacy College Admissions Test (PCAT) is **not required**. Prerequisite coursework must be completed prior to matriculation and can be marked "in progress" at the time of application.

TUITION AND FEES:

Tuition for the 2022-2023 academic year

- | MBA: \$1,020 per credit hour
- | Pharm.D.: \$1,138 per credit hour

If admitted, a nonrefundable enrollment deposit is required to hold your position in the Pharm.D. program. The deposit will be applied towards your tuition.
