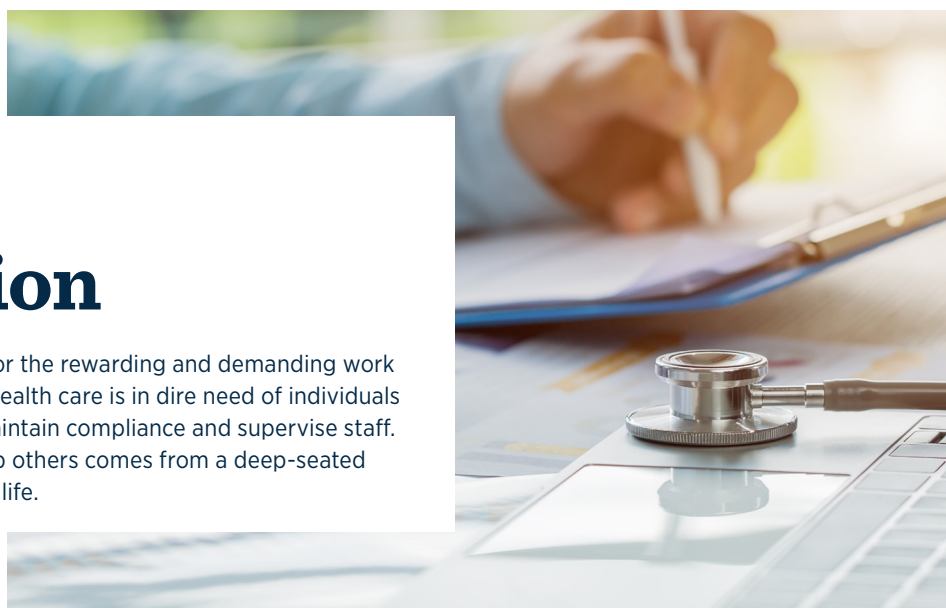


Health Care Administration
