## One year to a nursing career.

The accelerated nursing program offers students the opportunity to complete the B.S. in Nursing degree in one year. The focal point of this hands-on nursing program is health promotion and disease prevention. Curriculum includes both classroom instruction and a variety of clinical experiences.
