CLINICAL EDUCATION

A minimum of 750 clinical hours will be completed across the Front Range (Ft. Collins to Colorado Springs, and Boulder to Aurora). Clinicals are primarily held Wednesday through Friday. Some rotations are occasionally in the evenings and/or weekends. Clinicals in your last semester can be any day of the week.



Program Overview

Regis University's Accelerated BSN program offers students the opportunity to complete the Bachelor of Science in Nursing degree in one year. Any student who holds a bachelor's degree in a field other than nursing is eligible to apply for this program. You'll gain crucial insights into health promotion and disease prevention through a curriculum that includes both classroom instruction and clinical experiences, including three graduate-level nursing courses.
