CLINICAL EDUCATION

A minimum of 750 clinical hours will be completed across the Front Range (Ft. Collins to Colorado Springs, and Boulder to Aurora). Clinicals are primarily held Wednesday through Friday. Some rotations are occasionally in the evenings and/or weekends. Clinicals in your last semester can be any day of the week.

Program Overview

CHOICE offers you the same opportunities and challenges as a traditional BSN program, while helping you make the most of your time. Classes are held in the evenings twice per week on Regis' Northwest Denver campus, and clinical rotations are scheduled on weekends at our clinical partner sites.
