CLINICAL EDUCATION
A minimum of 750 clinical hours will be completed across the Front Range (Ft. Collins to Colorado Springs, and Boulder to Aurora). Clinicals are typically held Monday through Friday. Clinicals in your last semester can be any day of the week.

Program Overview

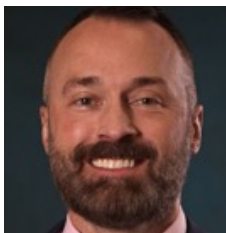
