ABOUT THE AWARD

Regis invites you to compete for one **\$12,000 scholarship, renewable for four years** to an incoming Religious Studies major. The approximate value of this award is \$48,000.

- The four-year award is renewable based on 3.0 GPA
- Award may be used toward an approved one semester study abroad program

IMPORTANT DATES

- Priority entry deadline: Friday, February 25, 2022 by 5 pm MT
- Award recipient notification: Tuesday, March 15, 2022

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- If selected for the scholarship, you must major in Religious Studies
- You must submit your essay per the instructions below to be considered for this competition
- You must be an admitted student for the fall of 2022 to be awarded the scholarship

SCHOLARSHIP CONSIDERATION

To be considered for this scholarship you must email your essay, limited to 500-750 words, 2 pages maximum, plus a title page, by the priority deadline date. Email subject line and document title must include your full name, high school, and essay title (example: Jane Smith_High School_Ignatian Leadership Award). Please include in the title page with your essay ALL of the following:
