

Xavier-Louisiana PharmD & Regis MS in Health Services Administration



Financial Aid Information

The dual degree in PharmD and MS in Health Services Administration is a unique offering for students interested in focusing on the business side of health care. Students seeking to borrow federal student loans must complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at studentaid.gov and include both Xavier University's and Regis University's Federal School Codes (**002032** and **001363**) each year.

At Regis University, the Summer 2023 semester requires the 2023-23 FAFSA to be completed. You will use that same FAFSA at Xavier University for Fall 2023 and Spring 2024.

As a participant in the dual-degree program, you will be a student at both Xavier and Regis, and you will have your own unique **student ID** and **email** at both schools, as well as a **separate financial aid file**. Each financial aid office will communicate with you directly regarding items needed, next steps and disbursement of your student loans.

As part of the program, you will take courses at Regis during the summer semesters in between your fall/spring semesters at Xavier. You will work independently with both financial aid offices regarding your tuition and loan eligibility.

Important Details:

- Regis University will offer federal Graduate PLUS Loans up to the cost of attendance (COA) for the summer semester. Students are required to complete the PLUS loan application at studentaid.gov and complete the **PLUS Entrance Counseling** and a **Master Promissory Note (MPN)**.
- Regis will **not** offer the Federal Direct Unsubsidized Student Loan in the summer semester, which will allow students to receive the yearly aggregate amount at Xavier for the academic year. Questions regarding loan eligibility and amounts should be addressed to the financial aid offices at both institutions.
- Xavier University will review and offer Federal Direct Unsubsidized Student Loans and Graduate PLUS Loans up to the COA for the fall and spring terms.
