What steps have you taken to rectify this? What can you do to be successful academically in graduate school?

Elaborate (1,000 words or less) upon the tradition(s) in the history or field of counseling/psychology that have most influenced and shaped your understanding of the practice of counseling (e.g. the scientific tradition, depth psychology, humanistic counseling, family therapy). This section will give the Admissions Committee a better understanding of the orientation you bring to your studies and/or the particular areas of interest you wish to pursue.

Post-Master's Certificate in Depth Psychotherapy Essay
