



WEEKLY INFORMATION FOR RANGERS AND THEIR FAMILIES

Sign Up for Housing or File an Exemption.

First- and second-year students are required to live on campus unless a Housing Exemption Form is completed and approved by the Office of Housing and Residential Engagement.

Incoming first-year students are eligible to live in either [O'Connell Hall](#) or [DeSmet Hall](#). If you are an incoming transfer student and you have lived in a college/university residence hall for at least two consecutive semesters (not including summer) or are over the age of 21, you are eligible to live in either [West Hall](#), the [Residence Village](#) or [Ignatian Village](#).

Students seeking on-campus housing or requesting an exemption can now submit their applications via the Front Porch Housing portal. Hurry, applications for housing and exemptions are due June 1.

All first-year and sophomore students living on campus are required to have either Meal Plan A or Meal Plan B each semester. Meal plans are available for commuter students, but are not required. Meal Plan A is automatically added to residential student accounts, but you can change your meal plan selection up until the first Friday of each semester. Questions?
