The [Office of Student Affairs](#) is home to the Dean of Students and their staff. The Vice President of Student Affairs is Dr. Barbara Wilcots, and a new Dean of Students will be named in the coming weeks.



The [Student Engagement and Leadership](#) team is led by Dave Law, a Regis legend who has been on our campus for over 20 years.
