Regis University provides a variety of student job opportunities for both workstudy and non-work-study students. Earn a paycheck every two weeks to help with personal expenses while you're in school and get more involved with the Regis community! From Admissions Student Ambassador to Biology Lab Preparation Assistant to Commuter Assistant in Student Life, we have lots of positions that can help you earn money, gain professional experience, build your resume, and establish strong connections on campus.

As you arrive to Regis and settle into your first week of classes, you'll start seeing student job opportunities posted on Workday (our Human Resources platform). To be considered for work-study employment, you must complete a Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA; filing required yearly). Not sure if you have a work study award? It's easy to find out! Visit the Ranger Portal and select "My Awards" in the Financial Aid section.
