The Office of the First Year Experience (FYE) exists to support every student during their transition to university life. Collaborating closely with faculty, staff, students, and community partners, FYE provides a range of resources and experiences designed to help you develop essential skills and knowledge, as well as a deep sense of belonging.

The FYE is made up of three key elements: a foundational core sequence, a cohort to bond over shared and differing views, and a faculty advisor to connect you to resources. The FYE will also introduce you to the Jesuit model of lifelong learning through experience, reflection and action.

Your first-year core seminar is also referred to as RCC 200 (or RCC 400 for transfer students). Each year, Regis offers incoming students RCC courses exploring a wide variety of subjects – your RCC classmates make up your first year cohort, and your RCC instructor serves as your academic advisor during your first year at Regis.

Your Foundational Core Sequence: Incoming students take a fall writing-intensive seminar (RCC 200/400), which is automatically paired with a spring communicationintensive seminar. Although all RCC 200/400 courses are designed to help develop your skills as a writer, each one focuses on a different subject, from superheroes to Zen Buddhism.
