Please read the following details carefully for your chosen scholarship competition. To be fully eligible for a scholarship, you must complete <u>all</u> requirements outlined below, including the pre-competition requirements, in-person competition requirements and post-competition requirements.



Additional details and specific instructions will be provided during the in-person competitions. All scholarship award recipients will be announced and notified by Friday, March 17, 2023.

Eligibility

Business and Computer Science Scholars is open to students planning to major or minor in a discipline offered by the <u>Anderson College of Business and Computing</u>. Recipients of full-tuition awards must **major** in a discipline offered by the Anderson College of Business and Computing.

Pre-Competition Requirements

- Watch this short video, "The Importance of Liberal Arts" featuring Geoffrey Bateman, Ph.D.
- Write an essay of no more than 250 words responding to the following prompt:

 The year is 2035, predict what your life looks like with a liberal-arts-grounded business or computer science degree from Regis University.
- Submit your essay via the <u>essay submission form</u> by **5 p.m. MT** on **Thursday, February 9, 2023** to be considered.

Essay guidelines:

- o 12-point Times New Roman font
- o Include your first name, last name and competition in the file name (example: FirstLastName_Business.doc) and save as one of the following file types: .pdf, .doc, .docx
- o Do not zip or compress your files
- Prepare a single presentation slide for the in-person competition. Your slide must be emailed to <u>visitru@regis.edu</u> by 5 **p.m. MT** on the Wednesday prior to the competition weekend in which you're competing. If no slide is received by this deadline, you will be provided with a slide containing only your name on the day of your presentation. See details below.

In-Person Competition Requirements

- Attend the Business and Computer Science Scholars competition during the weekend of either **February 10-11** or **February 17-18**, **2023**. In-person participation both Friday and Saturday is mandatory to be fully considered for a scholarship.
- Make a brief (3-5 minute) presentation to a small group on the following topic: "Describe the role of business and/or technology in society and where you fit in."

Presentation Slide Guidelines:

- You may use one PowerPoint slide as a visual aid for your presentation
- Save your final slide as a .ppt or .pptx file
- Name your final slide like this: FirstLastName_BusinessSlide (example: JaneSmith_BusinessSlide)

Post-Competition Requirements

If selected for a scholarship, recipients must be willing to participate in an interview and provide a photo for a scholarship recipient spotlight. Recipients may also be asked to write a "thank you" note to the generous donors who make Scholarship Month possible.

Admitted Student Visit Award

All students who participate in the in-person competitions during Scholarship Month and enroll at Regis University will automatically receive one micro-scholarship as part of our admitted student visit award program. Colorado-based students will receive \$500, while out-of-state students will receive \$1,000. **Please note:** recipients must participate in ALL aspects of Scholarship Month, including pre- and post-competition requirements.
