SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

- 1. Did you know that Regis University offers an Irish Community Scholarship?
- 2. The scholarship is renewable for a total of four years.
- 5. The recipients(s) will be selected from the pool of incoming freshmen students based on merit. Financial need will also be considered according to the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA). Applicants who submit the FAFSA before March 15th will be given priority consideration.
- 4. The recipient(s) will be full-time undergraduate students working on their first bachelor's degree.
- 5. Recipient(s) previous year's grade point average must be 3.0 or above.
- **6.** Eligibility for scholarships shall NOT be limited to applicants of Irish descent.
- 7. Recipient(s) will submit a 1,000-1,500 word essay on the impact of an Irish or Irish-American individual on an American community. The essay can be about current or historical subjects. The essay should include word count and citations and will be judged on:
 - Organization
- > Originality, voice, and style
- > Strong points and ample evidence > Form/presentation/accuracy
- 8. The recipient(s) will be selected by a review committee of Regis University faculty and staff who will read and evaluate the essays.
- 9. The winning essay must be judged best in comparison to competing essays. The essay becomes the property of Regis University.
- 10. Recipient(s) agree to the release of their information to the donors associated with the scholarship, as well as to publish their information in media releases and other publications.
