Leadership Scholars

Please read the following details carefully for your chosen scholarship competition. To be fully eligible for a scholarship, you must complete <u>all</u> requirements outlined below, including the pre-competition requirements, in-person competition requirements and post-competition requirements.



Additional details and specific instructions will be provided during the in-person competitions. All scholarship award recipients will be announced and notified by Friday, March 17, 2023.

NOTE: If you are competing in both the Leadership Scholars and the Peace and Justice Scholars competitions, you only need to submit one pre-competition essay, but you must indicate in the essay submission form that you would like to participate in both competitions. To participate in both the Leadership and Peace and Justice competitions, you must be registered for both weekends.

Eligibility

Leadership Scholars is open to students planning to major or minor in a discipline offered by the <u>Anderson College of Business and Computing</u> or <u>Regis College</u>. Recipients of full-tuition awards must **major** in a discipline offered by the Anderson College of Business and Computing or Regis College.

Students planning to major in pre-nursing, pre-pharmacy, health and exercise science and health care administration are **not** eligible to compete in this scholarship competition.

Pre-Competition Requirements

- Watch this short video, "The Importance of Liberal Arts" featuring Geoffrey Bateman, Ph.D.
- Write a 250-300 word essay detailing your own reaction to the video with the following guiding question: How will a liberal arts education prepare you for your life after college?
- Submit your essay via the <u>essay submission form</u> by **5 p.m. MT** on **Thursday, February 9, 2023** to be considered.

Essay guidelines:

- o 12-point Times New Roman font
- o Include your first name, last name and competition in the file name (example: FirstLastName_Leadership.doc) and save as one of the following file types: .pdf, .doc, .docx
- Do not zip or compress your files
- Complete these 10 short readings and take notes prior to attending the in-person competition.

In-Person Competition Requirements

Attend the Leadership Scholars competition during the weekend of either **February 10-11** or **February 17-18, 2023**. Inperson participation both Friday and Saturday is mandatory to be fully considered for a scholarship.

Post-Competition Requirements

The Leadership Scholars competition may require a final submission after the in-person competitions. Completion of this assignment is mandatory to be fully considered for a scholarship. Specific details will be provided during the in-person competitions. The deadline for final submissions is 11:59 p.m. MT on the Monday following the in-person competition in which you compete.

If selected for a scholarship, recipients must be willing to participate in an interview and provide a photo for a scholarship recipient spotlight. Recipients may also be asked to write a "thank you" note to the generous donors who make Scholarship Month possible.

Admitted Student Visit Award

All students who participate in the in-person competitions during Scholarship Month and enroll at Regis University will automatically receive one micro-scholarship as part of our admitted student visit award program. Colorado-based students will receive \$500, while out-of-state students will receive \$1,000. **Please note:** recipients must participate in ALL aspects of Scholarship Month, including pre- and post-competition requirements.
