



## Prerequisites Doctor of Pharmacy Transfer Guide from Regis Catalog 2021-2022

### Transfer Guide Covers Credits Earned from any Colorado Community College

#### Prerequisites for Doctor of Pharmacy

The Doctor of Pharmacy program is 150 hours of full-time study, offered in nine semesters over four years. Prerequisite work must be completed prior to matriculation in the School of Pharmacy. A minimum of 72 hours of prerequisite course work is required prior to entry into the program. Due to the dynamic nature of knowledge in the biological and chemical sciences, there is a seven year limit on those prerequisite courses. However, this time limit may be waived if the applicant has a prior Bachelor's Degree or higher.
