



Prerequisites Doctor of Physical Therapy Transfer Guide from Regis Catalog 2020-21

Transfer Guide Covers Credits Earned from any Colorado Community College Prerequisites for Doctor of Physical Therapy

The Doctor of Physical Therapy program is 110 hours of full-time study, offered in eight semesters over three years. Prerequisite course work must be completed prior to matriculation in the School of Physical Therapy. A minimum of 2.75 prerequisite GPA is required, and a 3.0 cumulative GPA is recommended. Due to the dynamic nature of knowledge in the required prerequisite courses, there is a recommended five-year limit on those prerequisite courses. However, Regis will consider all courses regardless of the amount of time since completion.

**Behavioral Sciences include courses in Psychology, Sociology and Anthropology. Developmental and Abnormal Psychology are recommended.
