Students must renew their FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) by our **March 1** priority deadline and submit any required financial aid documents by **May 1** each year to be considered an on-time applicant for other forms of aid, including grants and work-study.

2. Provide an **academic plan from your Academic Advisor** confirming the classes you need to graduate along with a plan for the upcoming semester(s) to progress towards graduation.
