

Over \$50,000 in scholarships available for transfer students seeking an initial Bachelor's degree in a Regis University accelerated or online program. Students with previous Bachelor's degrees are not eligible.

Transfer Success Scholarship — \$2,000 Total

Description	Designated for undergraduate applicants of Regis University pursuing an accelerated program, who are transferring in from any regionally accredited college or university with at least 30 credits and a 3.0 GPA or above.
Initial Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">> Must be an active undergraduate applicant and accepted to one of Regis University's accelerated programs> Must have cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above> Must transfer at least 30 credits from a regionally accredited college or university> Complete the scholarship application, submit transcript copies, and a 500-word essay describing how completing your Bachelor's degree at Regis University will support your educational, personal, and professional goals.
Continued Eligibility	Must maintain half-time enrollment or more and a 3.0 GPA for first two semesters to maintain eligibility
Disbursement	The \$2,000 will be split and divided over the first two 16-week academic semesters (\$1,000 per full semester) of attendance. Awards will be applied to Regis tuition only. If student postpones initial enrollment start date, the scholarship will be forfeited and any consideration for a future award requires re-submitting all required scholarship materials. The award is forfeited if breaks in attendance occur between terms. Consecutive enrollment is required to receive the scholarship for the two semesters it is awarded.
Deadline	Must be postmarked by July 15th for fall, November 15th for spring, and March 15th for summer start dates
Notification	Scholarship winners will be notified by August 15th for fall, December 15th for spring, and April 15th for summer start dates. Scholarships are competitive and a limited number will be awarded per year. Awards are applied to tuition for Regis University only.

Colorado Community College Scholarship — \$3,000 Total

Description	Designated for applicants of Regis University pursuing an accelerated program, who have completed their Associate's degree at one of the Colorado Community Colleges and are transferring in at least 60 credits to Regis with a 3.0 GPA or above.
Initial Eligibility	<ul style="list-style-type: none">> Must be accepted to one of Regis University's accelerated programs> Must have cumulative GPA of 3.0 or above and have completed an Associate's degree (by enrolled start date at Regis) from a regionally accredited Colorado Community College> Must transfer at least 60 credits from a regionally accredited Colorado Community College> Complete the scholarship application, submit transcript copies, and a 500-word essay describing how completing your Bachelor's degree at Regis University will support your educational, personal, and professional goals.
Continued Eligibility	Must maintain half-time enrollment or more and a 3.0 GPA for first two semesters to maintain eligibility
Disbursement	The \$3,000 will be split and divided over the first two 16-week academic semesters (\$1,500 per full semester) of attendance. Awards will be applied to Regis tuition only. If student postpones initial enrollment start date, the scholarship will be forfeited and any consideration for a future award requires re-submitting all required scholarship materials. The award is forfeited if breaks in attendance occur between terms. Consecutive enrollment is required to receive the scholarship for the two semesters it is awarded.

* The Transfer Success Scholarship and Colorado Community College Scholarship may replace, but will not be awarded in addition to other Regis University scholarships.
