LEARNING FORMAT	Online & On Campus	Low-Residency – study remotely with a faculty mentor (via email, Skype, and online) and attend 5, 9-day intense residencies on campus over the course of the program	Online & On Campus	All courses occur in the Global Classroom at the Posner Center for International Development. Classes are synchronous and may be attended in person or remotely, from anywhere on Earth. Class time is concentrated into two weekly class periods of two hours each that fall outside of sleeping and generally, working hours, no matter where students are located.
