## Internship Qualifications

Those students who are selected to the Volunteer Internship Program must be:

- A U.S. citizen
- Attending a college or university that is accredited by one of the regional or national institutional associations recognized by the United States Secretary of Education
- Classified as a Junior or Senior (a participant cannot be graduating before the program begins) attending a college or university; or a Graduate student enrolled in a college or university full-time
- Minimum cumulative grade point average (GPA) of 3.0 or above on a 4.0 scale, and in good standing with their academic institution
- Able to meet all FBI employment requirements as well as be able to pass an FBI Background Investigation and receive a Top Secret Security Clearance

## Benefits to Becoming an FBI Volunteer Intern

- Obtain a Top Secret Clearance
- In this volunteer non-paid position, you may earn academic credit
- Work side-by-side with Special Agents and Professional Staff personnel on important cases and management issues
- Gain insight into the full breadth of FBI careers and explore possible FBI employment after graduation
- Summer internships are approximately 10 weeks, usually beginning early in June and ending in mid-August
- Opportunity to intern in local FBI Field Offices in the Northeast, Southeast, North Central, South Central, Northwest, Southwest and the Washington, DC Metropolitan area
- At the end of the summer students may be offered the opportunity to continue the internship throughout the school year at an office nearest their school
- Many are afforded an opportunity to transition into a full time position upon graduation

*FBI's long range personnel needs include, but are not limited to: Computer Science, Engineering, Information Technology, Physical Science, Foreign Languages, Business, International Relations/Finance, Communications, Human Resources, Accounting, Law, and Behavioral Science*

*2013 Cyber Initiative: Due to the current critical needs of the Bureau, the Volunteer Internship Program is also seeking, but not limited to, individuals who have Cyber related educational backgrounds. These individuals should be majoring in or possess degrees in: Computer Forensics, Computer Science, Information Security, Digital Investigation Management, Network & Communications Management, Computer Engineering, Software Engineering, Information Systems, and Information Technology.*
