You are required to complete your academic program before the program end date on your I-20. If you are unable to do so, then you must apply for an I-20 extension. To be eligible for an extension, you must:

- Apply for an extension before the program end date on your I-20
- Have continually maintained F-1 status
- Be making academic progress towards your degree
- Have a compelling reason for the delay of your program completion that is accepted by the USCIS
- Show proof of financial documentation for the duration of the extension

Instructions: You must contact your academic advisor in order to complete this form. Once this form has been completed by you and your advisor, please return it with new financial documentation before the program end date on your I-20.
