

## MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ACCOUNTING DEGREE PROGRAM

This degree is designed for those interested in broadening and deepening their skills in accounting. The program has a strong foundation in ethics which is in high demand by corporations and accounting licensing bodies. The M.S. in Accounting degree program has been designed to be flexible, allowing students to focus on classes that will support their career goals, rather than restrict them to a “one size fits all” degree.
