

MASTER OF SCIENCE IN ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP DEGREE PROGRAM

The Master of Science in Organization Leadership is an intensive, accelerated, post-traditional, integrated learning experience. It is designed to change the way our students think about leadership. The Organizational Leadership degree teaches we all possess the capacity for leadership, but only those who cultivate it will ever become truly effective leaders. We strive in this program to encourage our students to develop the leader in each of them—to become part of the next generation of effective, ethical and socially responsible leaders. The program focuses on the issues of leadership and stewardship in a global environment, through the understanding of contemporary topics such as strategy, change, corporate social responsibility, ethics and emotional intelligence.

DEGREE REQUIREMENTS

Courses are offered online and in the classroom

Core Courses (9 credit hours)

If possible, this should be taken as the first course.

- ▶ LDR 6630 – Organizational Culture and Design
- ▶ LDR 6710 – Strategic Leadership

Capstone (3 credit hours)

- ▶ LDR 6830 – Strategic Corporate Social Responsibility

Total Degree Requirements = 30 credit hours

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- ▶ Completed online application with \$50.00 fee
 - ▶ Official degree-bearing transcripts
 - ▶ Resume
 - ▶ Essay
 - ▶ Once all documentation has been received, an Admission Committee reviews the application and the committee makes an admission recommendation. *(GMAT/GRE may be required at the discretion of the committee.)*
